# Disaster Prevention Day on September 1 (Sun.) Special Feature for Disaster Prevention

The month of September is the season when many typhoons occur. Due to natural disasters such as heavy rain and windstorm, much damage occurred in the past in Inzai City such as building collapse, road flooding, landslides, fallen trees and prolonged blackout.

In order to minimize damage, it will be important to take measures and prepare in advance.

#### Prepare the "My Timeline" (an evacuation action plan for your family)

The "My Timeline" means an evacuation action plan that has been organized in chronological order in advance

("When?" / "Who?" / "What to do?") in preparation for occurrence of major floods/landslides due to approaching typhoons, etc. Therefore, you should prepare the action plan suitable for your family by utilizing the "Evacuation Kid" (an introductory tool for preparing the "My Timeline" recommended by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism") / the "My Timeline Preparation Manual" on the website of Inzai City.





Get correct information to share it with your family/neighbors. Information Communication Tools regarding disasters, etc.

Inzai City will use various means of the Governmental Emergency Radio System, etc. in order to offer information. According to each situation of disasters, etc., it will be affected on each information communication tool. Therefore, use various means to offer information.

## Points about Evacuation Information – when the "Warning Level 4" is issued, you must evacuate –

The "Evacuation" aims to avoid a trouble (i.e., ensure safety).

Therefore, if you are in any safe place, you will not be required to evacuate.
