## FIRST LEGO League Challenge World Championship

### Harayama Junior High School Team "INZAI Tourmaline" Wins 3rd Place

Five students from Harayama Junior High School, as the team "INZAI Tourmaline," participated in the FIRST LEGO League Challenge World Festival (International Open) held in Sydney, Australia, from July 3 to 6. Among the 59 teams that had won national qualifiers worldwide, they achieved an overall third-place finish.

The four-day event included presentations on research projects addressing social issues (Innovation Project), robot games, robot design presentations, and Core Values, in which the teams competed.



Before departing for the competition, the "INZAI Tourmaline" visited the city office and shared their aspirations for the event. On July 25, after their return, the five students once again visited the city office to report their results at the World Festival to the Mayor.

#### What is the FIRST LEGO League Challenge (FLL)?

FLL is a STEAM education program designed for youth aged 9 to 16.

Teams that pass national qualifiers participate in the world championship, where they compete for points through robot games and presentations.

The program also aims to foster interaction and exchange among participants.

# Points about Evacuation Information – when the "Warning Level 4" is issued, you must evacuate –

The "Evacuation" aims to avoid a trouble (i.e., ensure safety).

Therefore, if you are in any safe place, you will not be required to evacuate.
