

Fureai Bus Service to Relaunch Starting Sunday, February 1, 2026 (Reiwa 8)

The Fureai Bus, which has been a familiar means of transportation for local residents, has undergone a review of its operating routes and schedules with the aim of creating more convenient and user-friendly public transport.

Key changes in this review include: a new addition of the Makinohara Loop Route, an increase in service from the previous 6 routes (58 trips) to 7 routes (74 trips). Specific timetables (and route maps) are distributed at public facilities within the city and on the city's website (via 2D code/QR code).


